# **Freight Mobility Plan**

FMATS is working with the Alaska State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and consultant HDR Alaska, Inc. on creating a Freight Mobility Plan (FMP) for the Fairbanks and North Pole areas.

The Draft Existing Conditions Report is available for comment. Comments are requested by December 1, 2016.

# **Transportation Alternative Program**

The next round of the FMATS TAP Program will include funding up to \$929,276. The FMATS Application and evaluation process are currently being revised to be more comprehensive and with a more specific evaluation criteria. FMATS expects to release the program late this winter for eligible agencies to apply for the available funding. There is a 9.03% sponsor match.

## **Metropolitan Transportation Plan**

The Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) is a blueprint guiding transportation project priorities, short to long range, which address transportation issues in the Fairbanks Metropolitan area. The MTP seeks to balance investment in various transportation modes against anticipated funding from federal, state and local sources.

The new MTP will project and identify transportation projects to implement in the next 20 years and be fiscally constrained. Negotiations are currently underway with a consultant and are scheduled to be finalized by end of year.
