Attached for approval and inclusion in the STIP, required under 23 USC 450.326, is the Fairbanks Metropolitan Area Transportation System (FMATS) 2012 – 2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #3. This TIP Amendment was developed in conformance with 23 USC 134 and all applicable federal requirements for Metropolitan Planning Organizations and is fiscally constrained. The FMATS Policy Committee approved this document, pending receipt of no significant comments, as of July 23, 2012. See attached action items documenting this approval. Interagency consultation was conducted regarding FMATS' finding that a conformity determination was not required for this Amendment. This documentation is also attached.

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## **FMATS 2012 - 2015 FMATS TIP AMENDMENT #3 - APPROVED**

**July 23, 2012**

### **Purpose of this TIP Amendment**

This is Amendment #3 to the 2012 – 2015 Fairbanks Metropolitan Transportation System (FMATS) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). It was developed primarily to include the College Road Corridor Study in the TIP. FMATS also decided to add additional projects to the Illustrative portion of the TIP, including the FMATS Streetlight Conversion Project Stage III, the Metropolitan Transportation Plan and the North Pole Interchange Pedestrian Facility Project. The Gold Hill Road Bicycle and Pedestrian Facility scope was also clarified in this Amendment. A state funded City of Fairbanks Downtown Wayfinding Project was added to the TIP. College Road Rehabilitation was moved from FFY13 to FFY14 for construction and the funding type for the University Avenue Widening Project was modified to use GO Bonds in FFY12 instead of earmark, FCTP and GCTP funding per DOT & PF's request. FMATS has also moved the construction phase for the North Pole Pedestrian Interchange Project to FFY13 from FFY14 to offset the College Road delay and based on new information that this project may be able to obligate late in FFY13. Other funding changes, previously approved by the authority of staff and the Policy Committee are also included in this Amendment. Additional funds received in the State's FY13 capital budget are also included in this Amendment.

This Amendment was anticipated to address significant project delays and FMATS has worked with the DOT & PF in establishing a banking request for funds that were to be obligated this year but cannot be until FFY14. The DOT & PF has agreed, by a letter written 5.18.12, to accommodate banking the requested \$3,532,600 until FFY14.

The draft Amendment was presented to the Technical Committee on June 6, 2012, and to the Policy Committee on June 20, 2012 when it was approved to be released for public comment. The Amendment was out for comment until July 20, 2012. No comments were received. The TIP continues to be fiscally constrained.

Interagency consultation began on June 22, 2012 to review FMATS' finding that a new conformity determination was not required as all projects were considered in the previous conformity analysis. Concurrence from FHWA and FTA was received on June 27, 2012 and from DEC on June 29, 2012.

This TIP amendment was developed in conformance with 23 USC 134, 49 USC 5303, 23 CFR Part 450, sections 174 and 176 (c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act as amended (42 USC 7504, 7506 (c) and (d)), 40 CFR Part 93, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act as amended (42 2000d-1) and 49 CFR Part 21, 49 USC 5332, Section 1101(b) of the SAFETEA-LU (Pub. L 109-59 and 49 CFR part 26, 23 CFR part 230,
